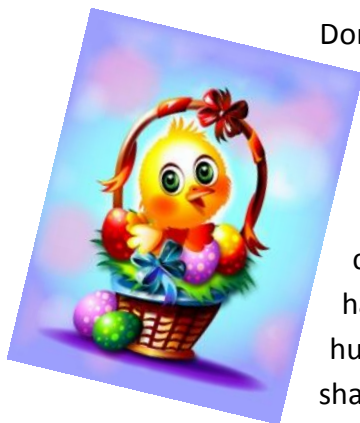


Happy Birthday

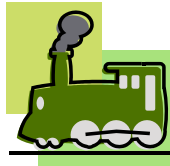
Puppet Show
